



## New Medicare Benefit

There is a new, fully covered educational and preventive care benefit for eligible seniors, with no out of pocket and no co-pay as part of the Patient Protection & Affordable Care Act of 2010.

Life Line Community Healthcare is working directly with Medicare to provide community-based Annual Wellness Visits (AWVs). Not an office visit, but rather a personal health & wellness consultation, an AWV is conducted by a board certified Nurse Practitioner and is designed to help doctors keep patients healthy, safe and independent for years to come. Unfortunately, most Medicare beneficiaries are not receiving, or aware of this valuable annual healthcare benefit.

AWV consultation includes:

- Screening for Depression Risk Factors
  - Evaluation of Memory Impairment
  - Review of Family and Medical History
  - BMI, Blood Pressure, Risk Factor Assessment
  - Review of Daily Living Skills, Fall Prevention, Home Safety
  - Personalized Advice for Health, Nutrition and Exercise
