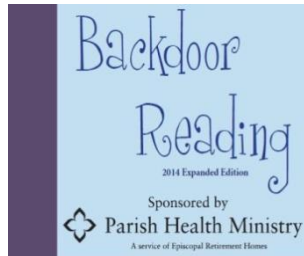




Expanded Edition of Backdoor Reading Is Now Available

One page information sheets with colorful pictures and information about various health topics are mounted inside of bathroom stall doors or over urinals “to reach a captive audience.” In bathrooms without stall doors, sheets are posted over the paper towel dispenser.
