Dear Residents and Families,

Two direct care staff members working at Episcopal Church Home have tested positive for COVID-19 and are self-quarantining at home. Residents in Memory Care West and Woodcock neighborhoods remain under quarantine at this time with dedicated staff. We will continue to conduct testing for these residents along with all ECH staff.

In addition, we have an occurrence of respiratory symptoms at MPL. An occurrence is defined as three or more residents and/or staff with new-onset COVID-19 respiratory symptoms in 72 hours. There are no trends or interactions among the staff and residents having respiratory symptoms. All involved are quarantined, have been tested, and we are awaiting results.
