Unfortunately, I must share with you that one of our residents at Episcopal Church Home, who we shared last week had tested positive for COVID-19, has passed away. We lift the resident, her beloved family, and the ECH staff in prayer during this time. I share the following prayer for our time of sorrow:

We come before You grateful for the life of the resident we lost to COVID-19. We are heartbroken that this moment has come. Still, we are grateful for the love our resident shared, the beauty she created and the strength of their Spirit.

We give thanks for your unfailing presence and the hope you provide in times of uncertainty and loss.

The other three residents are recuperating in quarantine. All staff and residents have been tested. The most recent round resulted in all residents and staff testing negative for COVID-19.

We also received notice that a non-direct care staff member at Marjorie Lee has tested positive for COVID-19. The staff member is self-quarantining at home.
