Dear Residents and Families,

Canterbury Court has had two more residents test positive for COVID-19. Additionally, we have had two residents test positive at Shawnee Place, two residents at Blanchester, and one resident at Madison Villa. The residents have been either asymptomatic or have mild symptoms at this time.

Because the communities listed above are Affordable Living and are non-healthcare communities, we cannot mandate the same restrictions we do in our retirement communities. However, if everyone follows the CDC recommended guidelines, the spread of the virus will stop. We have it within us to stop this virus – but it takes each of us – every day to follow the guidelines.

For these reasons, we are implementing the following best practices at Canterbury Court, Blanchester, and Shawnee Place and are strongly encouraging residents to do their part to stop the spread of the virus.

- Requesting all residents to quarantine in their apartments for the next 14 days to stop the virus's spread via asymptomatic residents.
- Stop all community gatherings for the next 14 days, including in the evenings when staff are away.
- Request that residents only have visitors for emergent healthcare needs for the next 14 days.

We also have one occurrence of symptoms to report at Marjorie Lee. As a reminder, an occurrence is defined as three or more residents or staff with new-onset COVID-19 respiratory symptoms in 72 hours.
