Dear Residents and Families,

We have two new cases of COVID-19 to report in our Affordable Living communities: one resident at Canterbury Court and one resident at our Blanchester location. In addition, residents and staff at Canterbury Court underwent COVID-19 testing on Monday; results are pending at this time.

At Marjorie P. Lee, three residents in Shaw Rehab have tested positive for COVID-19. The residents are quarantining at this time, and results are pending for other residents in that household. Additionally, the Morris Household is now on quarantine out of an abundance of caution. All residents have been tested, and results are pending.

Lastly, we have one occurrence of symptoms to report at ECH. As a reminder, an occurrence is defined as three or more residents or staff with new-onset COVID-19 respiratory symptoms in 72 hours.
