Dear Residents and Families,

As of today, we have not been contacted by the state or the contracted pharmacies related to the delivery of the vaccine. We will share information about the arrival of the vaccine as soon as it becomes available.

We continue to have cases of COVID-19 as our surrounding communities struggle with the rising incidence rate. For reporting today, we received positive COVID-19 results for one resident who lives in the Deupree Cottages. The resident was asymptomatic and is quarantining. Additionally, a direct care staff member who also works at the Cottages tested positive for COVID-19. The staff member is quarantining at home.

We also received five positive tests for staff at MPL during this week’s testing (two non-direct staff member and three private duty staff members working on Romney, Amstein, and Residential Living.) The staff are all quarantining at home. One resident who had recently moved from the Cottages to Marjorie Lee passed away. After the resident died, we learned that she was positive for COVID. Please keep the family and the staff who cared for the resident in your prayers.

Lastly, we have four staff members at ECH who have tested positive for COVID-19 (one non-direct care, one direct care staff member on the Morton Memory Care Household, and one direct care staff member on our COVID care center, and one Marimion direct caregiver.) The staff are all quarantining at home. One of our Memory Care residents tested positive during our routine surveillance as well. We also have an occurrence of respiratory symptoms. An occurrence is three or more residents or staff with new-onset COVID-19 respiratory symptoms in 72 hours.
