Dear Residents and Families,

For reporting today, we received positive COVID-19 results for one direct care staff member who works at the Deupree Cottages. The staff member is quarantining at home. All residents have been tested, and results are pending.

I am pleased to share that the Berghamer household is no longer in quarantine. Unfortunately, I must share that a resident at Marjorie Lee who had COVID-19 sometime ago continued to have other symptoms and has passed away. Even though the resident had other illnesses, we are reporting the passing to you as they had previously tested positive COVID-19. Please keep the family in your prayers during this difficult time.

We were notified by family members that two Affordable Living residents had been hospitalized, tested positive for COVID-19, and are recuperating at local nursing homes. The residents live at Madison Villa and Canterbury Court.
