Dear Residents and Families,

For reporting today, we received positive COVID-19 results for one Episcopal Church Home resident who lives on Clingman. Additionally, I share with a heavy heart that a resident at ECH had COVID-19 and passed away. The resident lived on Clingman. Please keep the family and the staff who have cared for the resident in your prayers.

I am pleased to share that we have received important information about the vaccine. Episcopal Church Home has received their clinic dates. On the following dates, the team from Walgreen's will be on-site to administer the vaccine.

- December 23<sup>rd</sup> from 2 p.m. – 6 p.m.
- January 13<sup>th</sup> from 2 p.m. – 6 p.m.
- February 3<sup>rd</sup> from 2 p.m. – 6 p.m.

At this point, residents and staff working in our nursing and personal care areas will be offered the vaccine. We are waiting for information about the vaccine for Duddley Square. We will work with residents and families to get treatment consents signed.

We have not heard about our Cincinnati retirement communities' clinic days but expect to hear very soon.
