Dear Residents and Families,

Tomorrow is an important day for ERS and Episcopal Church Home. We will be administering our first vaccines to residents and staff. The Right Reverend Terry White, Bishop of the Diocese of Kentucky, will join us for a virtual blessing. Additionally, we are beginning to get dates for our Cincinnati communities. The Deupree campus received word that the vaccine clinics will take place during the first full week of January. More details to follow in coming letters.

At Marjorie P. Lee, one private duty direct care staff member has tested positive for COVID-19 who works on the Luther Household. The staff member is quarantining at home, and the Luther Household remains under quarantine. Test results are pending for all residents who had close contact with this private duty.

At Deupree House, one direct care contracted staff member has tested positive for COVID-19. The staff member is quarantining at home. Test results are pending for all residents who had close contact with this contracted staff member.

Unfortunately, I must share that the family of a resident at Canterbury Court resident who was previously reported as having COVID-19 has passed away. Please keep the resident's family and the Canterbury team in your prayers. We also have one resident at our Affordable Living location, Maple Knoll Village, test positive for COVID-19. The resident is quarantining in their apartment at this time.
