Dear Residents and Families,

We continue to receive results from our surveillance and contact testing from before the holiday. At Episcopal Church Home, four residents on the Marmion Household tested positive for COVID-19. The residents are quarantining at this time on our COVID+ unit. Additionally, we have four staff members who have tested positive for COVID-19 (1 direct care staff on Woodcock, two direct care staff on Marmion, and one non-direct care staff member.) Staff are quarantining at home.

We are looking forward to our first vaccine clinic at Deupree House on Tuesday, January 5th. Unfortunately, Walgreens has shared that they will not share the date for the Marjorie Lee clinics until this week. We will share information as soon as it is available.
