Dear Residents and Families,

It is with a heavy heart that I share that two residents who lived on Marmion and had been previously reported as having COVID-19 have passed away. Please keep the residents' families and the Episcopal Church Home community in your prayers during this incredibly difficult time.

In addition, we have been notified that a resident from Knowlton Place, an ERS Affordable Living Community, has tested positive for COVID-19 and is receiving care at the hospital.

For reporting today, one non-direct care staff member at ECH has tested positive for COVID-19 and is quarantining at home.
