Dear Residents and Families,

We are excited about our second clinic at Deupree House and Cottages next week. **Our residents and staff will receive their second dose of the vaccine on Tuesday, January 26th, from 9:00 a.m. – 4:00 p.m.** Residents will receive notices from the leadership team detailing the specific time slot based on the floor on which they live.

I have received some questions about life after the vaccine. As you have heard from top medical experts, we still need to wear masks and social distance. The practical matter is that our guidelines will not change until the state agencies governing senior living modify their standards. We are keeping close contact with our sources and will share information with you as soon as it is available.

For reporting today, one direct care staff member at Marjorie Lee has tested positive for COVID-19. The staff member worked on the Berghamer Household and is quarantining at home.

At Deupree Cottages, one staff member and one resident have tested positive for COVID-19. Both resident and staff are quarantining.

Additionally, a resident at our Rachel Court Affordable Living campus has tested positive for COVID-19. The resident is quarantining at home at this time.
