Dear Residents and Families,

In our Affordable Living communities, a resident who lives at our Central Parkway location has tested positive for COVID-19. The resident is quarantining in their apartment.

**We are excited to announce that we are planning to open indoor visits at Marjorie P. Lee and Episcopal Church Home next week!** Indoor visits can occur as long as the community positivity rate for Hamilton and Jefferson Counties remains under 10%. In addition, there can be no positive cases of residents or staff in the last 14 days within the retirement community. **Because of the county positivity rate and are no cases in the last 14 days, our staff testing will be weekly, not bi-weekly, beginning the week of February 22<sup>nd</sup>.**

Below are details that we know so far:

- As of today, in the state of Kentucky, indoor visits may only be offered to vaccinated residents residing in Personal Care (Memory Care and Woodcock.)
- At Marjorie P. Lee, indoor visits will be offered to residents in all levels of care.
- Visitor guidelines vary by state guidelines:
  - In Ohio, only two visitors are allowed per visit. In Kentucky, the two visitors must live in the same household, otherwise, visitors are limited to one per resident.
  - Visitors must have a negative COVID-19 test to visit. In Kentucky, visitors who have had their second dose of the vaccine more than 14 days before the visit, will not be required to have a COVID test. In Ohio, visitors will be tested on-site on the day of the visit.
- Each visitor must be over the age of 2, wear a mask during the visit, and maintain social distancing.
- Visitors will be spaced 10 feet away from the resident without a barrier.
- Due to masks needing to be worn at all times during the visit, food and beverages are not able to be permitted during visits.
- Because of weekly testing for all staff and resident along with programming, visits will be offered several days a week, but not every day.
- Residents will be able to have one in-person visit per two-week period for the first several weeks to allow for all families to be reunited.
- Residents cannot participate in visits while in quarantine.
- Lastly, indoor visits will be changed to window visits if a resident or staff member tests positive for COVID-19 or if CMS lists Hamilton or Jefferson Counties at 10% or higher.

More details will be shared early next week regarding sign-up logistics and additional specifics for each location. We have waited a long time for these indoor visits and are eager to reunite families again in the coming days!
