Dear Residents and Families,

A direct caregiver from Berghamer House at Marjorie P. Lee has tested positive for COVID-19. The staff member is quarantining at home. Indoor visits are currently on hold for Berghamer; however, window visits are available. All other residents and staff have been tested and are negative for COVID-19 at this time. Therefore, vaccinated residents can leave for outings as planned including Easter.

Additionally, a resident residing in our affordable living community, Shawnee Place, has tested positive for COVID-19 and is quarantining in their apartment.

We have received word from state officials that we will have another vaccine clinic this month at Deupree House & Cottages and Marjorie Lee. If residents were not vaccinated during the clinic earlier this year, I strongly urge you to consider vaccination at this time. **Please reach out to your administrator if you wish to be on the list.**


