A direct care staff member who works on the Morton Household at Episcopal Church Home has tested positive for COVID-19. The staff member is quarantining at home. Per Governor's orders, outbreak testing is underway. Negative test results were received for staff and skilled nursing residents' tests following initial testing. Therefore, we will continue testing following the current guidelines.

I also want to share that one of our residents from Friendly Oaks Village, who previously reported testing positive for COVID-19, has passed away. Please join me in keeping the resident's family and the Friendly Oaks Village in your prayers. We have offered testing to residents, and fortunately, no other residents have tested positive at this time. A good friend said it well: "As much as we are all over COVID, unfortunately COVID is not over." The passing of one of our residents brings this home to me.
