Dear Residents and Family Members,

A vaccinated support staff member at Episcopal Church Home has tested positive for COVID-19. As a result, the staff member is quarantined at home. Residents are being tested in accordance with current regulations.

Two residents in our Affordable Living Communities (St. Paul Village and Knowlton Place) tested positive for COVID-19. Both residents were hospitalized. The resident living at Knowlton is now at home recuperating, but the St. Paul Village resident remains hospitalized at this time.
