Dear Residents and Families,

Two vaccinated direct care staff members who works at Marjorie Lee Retirement Community have tested positive for COVID-19. One staff member works on the Romney / Amstein Households and the other staff member works in residential care. As a result, the staff members and resident are quarantined. Residents and staff are being tested following current regulations. Additionally, we have an occurrence of symptoms at MPL. As you will recall, an occurrence is when three or more residents or staff with new-onset COVID-19 respiratory symptoms in a 72-hour period.

Additionally, because of the prevalence of the variant, we will be testing residents the first week in January at all of our CCRCs. All staff will be tested weekly over the next month at our CCRCs and support office staff as well.
