Dear Residents and Families,

We have several cases to report today. First, a member of the ERS Support Services team has tested positive for COVID-19 and is quarantining at home.

In Affordable Living, two residents at Canterbury Court have tested positive for COVID-19. One resident is quarantining at home, and the other is hospitalized at this time. Also, a staff member from Shawnee Place has tested positive for COVID-19 and is quarantining at home. In addition, a resident from Scheper Ridge tested positive for COVID-19 last month and has recovered.

At Deupree, a direct care staff member and two private duties have tested positive for COVID-19 and are quarantining at home. A resident at Deupree has also tested positive for COVID-19 and is quarantining in their apartment.

At Episcopal Church Home, a non-direct care staff member has tested positive for COVID-19 and is quarantining at home.

At Marjorie Lee, three direct care staff have tested positive for COVID-19 (Berghamer, Romney, and Cohort) and are quarantining at home.
