Dear Residents and Families,

In Affordable Living, a resident at Maple Knoll Meadows has tested positive for COVID-19 and is receiving care at the hospital.

Additionally, a member of the ERS Support Services team has tested positive for COVID-19 and is quarantining at home.

At Deupree, two non-direct care staff members have tested positive for COVID-19 and are quarantining at home. At Deupree Cottages, two direct caregivers have tested positive as well and are quarantining at home.

At Episcopal Church Home, a direct care staff member has tested positive and is quarantining at home.

At Marjorie Lee, two direct care staff members (Amstein, Romney) and two non-direct care staff members have tested positive for COVID-19 and are quarantining at home. Additionally, a direct care staff member that works across various households has tested positive and is quarantining at home. One resident has also tested positive and is quarantining in their apartment.
