With a heavy heart, I must share that a resident who lives at Marjorie Lee, who we previously shared had COVID-19, has passed away. Please keep our resident's families in your prayers.

In Affordable Living, two residents at our Canterbury Court Community have tested positive for COVID-19 and are quarantining in their apartments.

At Deupree Cottages, one direct staff member has tested positive for COVID-19 and is quarantining at home. Additionally, one non-direct care staff member at ECH who works on the Morton House East has tested positive for COVID-19 and is quarantining at home.

Lastly, at the ERS office, one staff member has tested positive for COVID-19 and is quarantining at home.

I also want to share that we can open a few areas within our Cincinnati retirement communities. Guest rooms at Marjorie Lee and Deupree House are now open for use. In addition, residents may have visitors participate in chapel services as long as social distance can be maintained.
