Dear Residents and Family Members,

As a seven-day follow-up to our letter last week, we are updating our mask protocol for our Continuing Care Retirement Communities.

Hamilton County is at Substantial transmission rates. **Therefore, residential living residents at Marjorie Lee and Deupree House are not required to wear masks in common areas.** However, we will continue encouraging residents to wear masks and keep the masks stations available. To live with COVID-19, holiday festivities will continue with food and drink. We will continue COVID-19 testing of staff and residents at Deupree House, Deupree Cottages, and Marjorie Lee this week.

Jefferson County remains at High transmission rates. **Therefore, Dudley Square residents must wear masks in the Clubhouse.** We will keep the masks stations available. We will continue COVID-19 testing of staff and residents at Episcopal Church Home this week.

Additionally, a resident who lives at our Affordable Living Thompson Meadows has tested positive for COVID-19 and is quarantining.
