Dear Residents and Family Members,

As I shared in my letter last week, the country's Public Health Emergency officially ends tomorrow, May 11th, 2023. With that said, this letter marks the last COVID-19 written update.

For reporting today, one non-direct staff member at Episcopal Church Home and one non-direct staff member at Marjorie P. Lee have tested positive for COVID-19 and quarantined at home. Additionally, one resident and one contracted direct caregiver at Deupree Cottages have tested positive for COVID-19 and are quarantining at this time. Finally, in Affordable Living, a resident from Central Parkway Place has tested positive for COVID-19 and is receiving care at the hospital.

I would also like to share the following updates for our retirement communities: Deupree House and Cottages, Marjorie Lee, and Episcopal Church Home. As of today, staff and visitors we will no longer be required to complete temperature and symptom screening when entering our retirement communities. Visitors will still be required to sign in, and we ask that anyone experiencing symptoms self-report to their community's administrator.

Additionally, visitors in our retirement communities may now use common spaces throughout the communities and attend life enrichment programs with loved ones and friends. We are also excited to share that a limited number of guest reservations will be available for the dining room. Community-specific details will be shared by the dining services teams in the coming days.
