Dear Residents, Staff, and Families:

We received test results yesterday that a staff member at Marjorie P. Lee (MPL) has tested positive for COVID-19. The staff member has not worked at MPL for almost three weeks. However, we wanted to share this new information with you. As we shared early this week, we have tested all residents in long term nursing and have received the following test results:

- Two residents tested positive: one living on Kirby and one on Amstein.
- All other residents on Amstein and Romney tested are negative.
- Test results from residents living on Berghamer, Kirby, and Luther are pending.

The residents have been moved to an isolation area and are under physicians' care.

Additionally, we have had another occurrence of symptoms. Staff and residents have been tested and are being isolated. We are awaiting results and will share updated when we receive them.

To contain the spread of COVID-19, we will continue the quarantine of Luther and Kirby Households. Additionally, Amstein and Romney are now quarantined. Staff are assigned to specific households and we not be allow to go between household during periods of quarantine. Residents will remain in their household.
