Dear Residents and Families:

Early this week, I reported that a resident at our Canterbury Court Affordable Living location tested positive for COVID-19. Unfortunately, the resident is hospitalized at a local hospital. The resident's spouse and their private duty staff member have also been tested positive for COVID-19. They both are quarantined. We are keeping in close contact with the residents' family and will keep them close in prayer.

The results from the Deupree House National Guard testing for staff are now complete. Of the 170 tests received, all were negative except for the one positive private duty reported previously. Again, all the Cottages residents were tested, and I am pleased to share that 100% of the residents' tests were negative for COVID.

We are still waiting on few outstanding tests for staff on Marimon household at the Episcopal Church Home. I am pleased to share that 100% of the residents' tests were negative for COVID. We are hopeful that the final tests will be back early next week.

We are receiving results from our weekly testing of Marjorie Lee households that are being quarantined at this time. We were notified today that one of the staff members on the Morris household has tested positive for COVID-19, however, was asymptomatic. The staff member is quarantined at home. Surveillance testing will continue for residents, and staff will continue, and the Morris households will remain in quarantine.
