The results from the bi-weekly testing of all staff and private duties are beginning to come back for ECH. One staff member has tested positive for COVID-19. The staff member works on the Morton area, but also interacted with a few residents on Woodcock. The staff member is self-quarantining at home. The residents who came in contact with the staff member have been quarantined.

Results from Marjorie Lee are still pending at this time. However, we were informed that a private duty staff member was tested positive. The individual worked with a resident on the Amstein Household. The private duty staff member is self-quarantining at home. The Amstein Household remains quarantined.
