Dear Residents and Families:

The results from the bi-weekly testing conducted the week of August 10th are now available. The following is a summary of the results:

- **Deupree House and Cottages** – as previously reported on August 14th, we had one positive test and 142 negative tests for an incidence rate of 0.70%
- **Episcopal Church Home** – as previously reported August 16th, we had one positive test of a staff member. We tested 14 residents who interacted with the staff member and all 14 were negative for COVID-19. We received 162 negative tests for an incidence rate of 0.61%. There were two staff tests that were indeterminant and had to be re-tested. Results are pending.
- **Marjorie Lee** – We finally received results late yesterday. We had one positive test of an asymptomatic staff member on Romney House. We received 278 negative tests and one indeterminant test for an incidence rate of 0.36%. The indeterminant test is being retested. The staff member who tested positive is self-quarantining at home. The individuals who came in contact with the employee are being retested.

Our next round of tests is scheduled for next week. **Both Marjorie Lee and Deupree House/Cottages will be tested on August 25th, and Episcopal Church Home will be tested on August 26th.**

I wanted to provide an update on the residents at Canterbury Court as well. The two residents that have tested positive for COVID-19 continue to recuperate and are self-quarantining at home.
