I am pleased to share with you that our Amstein Household at Marjorie Lee is no longer under quarantine. With this announcement, there are no households under quarantine. All residents and staff that have previously reported as positive for COVID-19 are recuperated and back to work or their original living area!

We have completed another round of testing for all staff and private duties at Deupree House and Marjorie Lee, and today are testing at the Episcopal Church Home. Bi-weekly testing is designed to catch asymptomatic individuals. I hope that we don't have to report positive cases when the test results come back; if we do, the process will have worked.
