Dear Residents and Families,

During our routine surveillance testing this week, one staff member at Marjorie Lee tested positive for COVID-19. The staff member is a non-direct care employee and is asymptomatic. They are quarantining at home. Because there was no resident exposure, we do not have to quarantine any residents at this time. We also had a positive case at the Deupree House and Cottages involving a private duty staff member. The staff member is quarantining at home. Residents and staff with exposure are being tested, and residents with direct exposure are being quarantined. As a reminder, private duty and contracted staff are reported to our residents and families, however, are not included in the cumulative chart based on reporting guidelines by the city and state.
