Dear Residents and Families,

I am writing to share that we received two positive tests for COVID-19 for staff working at the Cottages. Both staff members are quarantining at home. Indoor visits at Deupree House & Cottages will be delayed at least 14 days based on these positive tests. We also have one occurrence of respiratory symptoms.

Given what I am seeing in our county, I am not surprised with the number of cases this week, unfortunately. Every day I see examples of people not following the guidelines in Hamilton County. As you know, Hamilton County’s rate is teetering near the highest category. We know that what happening in the broader community DOES impact our residents. As DeWine has said many times: we have the power within us to stop the spread if we follow the guidelines. Please join me in asking our neighbors, friends, and everyone to wear masks whenever they are not at home.
