Dear Residents and Families,

We had a non-direct care staff member at Marjorie Lee, who has tested positive for COVID-19 during our routine surveillance testing. The staff member is quarantining at home. The staff member is in a role with no resident interaction.

We conducted our surveillance testing for the week. The results are back for Marjorie Lee and Deupree House. Additionally, we had one positive case at MPL (reported above) and 255 negative tests. We tested 163 staff members at Deupree House and Cottages. All test results were negative. As I reported yesterday, the first round of testing for the week at ECH were all negative. We are awaiting ECH's second testing for this week and will report results next week.
