Dear Residents and Families,

We have an occurrence of respiratory symptoms at Marjorie Lee. An occurrence is defined as three or more residents or staff with new-onset COVID-19 respiratory symptoms in 72 hours. There are no trends or interactions among the staff and residents having respiratory symptoms. All involved have been tested, and we are awaiting results.

As a follow-up from last week, the resident and staff at Shawnee Place, who tested positive for COVID-19, are doing well.

We have received the majority of ECH’s second testing from last week. At this time, we have received 159 negative tests and are waiting on three pending results.
