All you will need is either a valid ID (e.g., a driver's license or ID) OR the last four digits of your Social Security number

It's important to be registered to vote, as there's an election coming up on March 17. In addition to the primary elections, voters will have the final say on a levy to support the Metro Bus System.

ERS is working on possible transportation for early voting - more details on this later.
