Something's Gotta Give (2003)

Stars: Jack Nicholson, Diane Keaton, Keanu Reeves

Plot: When aging womanizer Harry Sanborn and his young girlfriend Marin arrive at her family's beach house in the Hamptons, they find that her mother, dramatist Erica Barry, also plans to stay for the weekend. Erica is scandalized by the relationship and Harry's sexist ways. But when Harry has a heart attack, and a doctor prescribes bed rest at the Barry home, he finds himself falling for Erica – who, for once, may be out of his league.

The Public (2019)

Stars: Emilio Estevez, Taylor Schilling, Alec Baldwin

Plot: An unusually bitter Arctic blast has made its way to downtown Cincinnati and the front doors of the public library. At odds with library officials over how to handle the extreme weather event, some homeless patrons turn the building into a shelter for the night by staging an "Occupy" sit in. What begins as an act of civil disobedience becomes a stand-off with police and a rush-to-judgement media constantly speculating about what's really happening.

As the interrogation gets underway, Joan relives the dramatic events that shaped her life and her beliefs.

On the run from the law, Nick seeks assistance from his ex-wife, Glenda, a big-hearted lawyer. Knowing he would never commit a crime, she lets him stay at her house despite the fact that her husband, Ira, a district attorney, is throwing a party for law enforcement officials.

Title: Silent Wings: The American Glider Pilots of WWII

Description: From the early race to build gliders to the D-Day Invasion at Normandy and Nazi Germany's final surrender, this documentary reveals the critical role gliders played in World War II offensives. Through rare archival footage and photographs, the film places the audience right at the center of the action in the dangerous world of the American glider pilot. During WWII 6000 young Americans volunteered to fly large unarmed cargo gliders into battle. For these glider pilots every mission was do-or-die. It was their task to repeatedly risk their lives landing the men and tools of war deep within enemy-held territory, often in complete darkness. Thousands of lives were saved and battles won because of their efforts.

Description: She left for New York City and worked hard as a model, stage actor, and TV player. And then she was discovered by Hollywood. In less than four years she was acknowledged as one of movie's most sought after stars and an Academy-Award winner, playing opposite some of the greatest leading men of her time. Suddenly, like a modern-day fairy tale, Grace Kelly turned her back on it all – to become Her Serene Highness Princess Grace of Monaco.
