

On Wednesday, June 16, 2021, a historic day occurred at ECH. Demolition began on the 1970's healthcare building. In anticipation of this moment, a bittersweet feeling filled the air. Over the last 40+ years, ECH has been privileged to care for many residents in this portion of the building and are thankful for all that entrusted us with their care. Residents and staff have shared many fond memories in this building that we will forever cherish in our hearts. As we further embrace our new, bold and exciting vision for ECH, we look forward to making new memories with you and our future residents.

A substantial amount of progress has been made in Dudley Square as well. All of the model homes have been painted, along with the installation of flooring and appliances. Plumbing fixtures were installed this week and electrical work is expected to be completed next week. The model homes are expected to be completed between late July and early August.

The Clubhouse is also progressing nicely as well. It has been framed out and the roof and windows have been installed. The Clubhouse is expected to be completed between late August and early September.

The next step in the Masterplan is to begin working on the new PC building. However, work is not expected to begin on the PC building for at least another 45 – 60 days, as demolition is expected to take a little over a month to complete.
