Mexicali Rose (1939)

Stars: Gene Autry, Smiley Burnette, Noah Beery

Plot: Gene Autry and his musical sidekick, Frog Millhouse (Smiley Burnette), find themselves in a pickle after Carruthers (William Royle), a new advertiser on Autry's popular radio program, swindles a slew of listeners into buying stock in a barren oil well. Determined to help recover funds intended for an orphanage run by the lovely Anita Loredo (Luana Walters), Autry, Millhouse, and a heroic vigilante Valdez (Noah Beery) plot to beat the heartless Carruthers at his own game.

Cyrano (2021) **Stars:** Peter Dinklage, Haley Bennett, and Kevin Harrison Jr.

Plot: Award – winning director Joe Wright envelops moviegoers in a symphony of emotions with music, romance, and beauty in Cyrano, re-imagining the timeless tale of a heartbreaking love triangle. A man ahead of his time, Cyrano de Bergerac (Peter Dinklage) dazzles whether with ferocious wordplay at a verbal joust or with brilliant swordplay in a duel. Where The Crawdads Sing (2022) **Stars:** Daisy Edgar-Jones, Taylor John Smith, Harris Dickinson

Plot: From the best-selling novel comes a captivating mystery. Where the Crawdads Sing tells the story of Kya, an abandoned girl who raised herself to adulthood in the dangerous marshlands of North Carolina. For years, rumors of the "Marsh Girl" haunted Barkley Cove, isolating the sharp and resilient Kya from her community. Drawn to two young men from town, Kya opens herself to a new and startling world; but when one of them is found dead, she is immediately cast by the community as the main suspect. As the case unfolds, the verdict as to what actually happened becomes increasingly unclear, threatening to reveal the many secrets that lay within the marsh.

Plot: The film explores the life and music of Elvis Presley (Austin Butler), seen through the prism of his complicated relationship with his enigmatic manager, Colonel Tom Parker (Tom Hanks). The story delves into the complex dynamic between Presley and Parker spanning over 20 years, from Presley's rise to fame to his unprecedented stardom, against the backdrop of the

evolving cultural landscape and loss of innocence in America. Central to that journey is one of the most significant and influential people in Elvis's life, Priscilla Presley (Olivia DeJonge).

Using an avalanche blocking the tracks to his advantage, Poirot gradually realizes that many of the passengers have revenge as a motive, and he begins to home in on the culprit.
