Cincinnati is the last stop on the tour and the Barn is honored to have both exhibits on display in the newly renovated loft space. Ten greater Cincinnati residents were also juried into the exhibits. These artists will be on hand, as well as other members of the Contemporary Quilt and Fiber Art group, to help visitors understand the exhibit and point out amazing fiber art techniques found on the quilts. Each year Cherrywood Fabrics challenges art quilters with a hand dyed fabric color and subject. Artists have six months to create a 20 x 20 inch art quilt to enter the contest with a quilt based on that subject. In 2017 the subject was Vincent Van Gogh. The second exhibition is in the Gallery area and features a variety of art work by artist Sandy Maudlin & Friends.
